



## The super easy "Play on My Bed" Quilt

Why play on the floor when you can play on your bed?

featuring the **Search and See Collection**

72" x 102"

**FINISHED STAR BLOCK SIZE: 16" x 16"**

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 71½" x 101"**

- *Quilt instructions are given for quilts in two different colorways.*
- *A separate materials list is given for each of the two quilts.*
- *Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.*

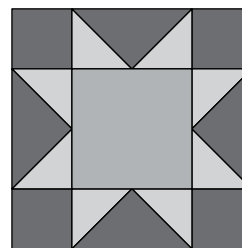
### **Materials: Teal Quilt**

- 1⅝ yds. or 2 yds.\* Black Road Map (1JHM1) for quilt center  
⅔ yd. or 1⅓ yds.\*\* Dark Primary Tiles (2JHM1) for blocks  
½ yd. Red Large Dots (4JHM1) for blocks  
½ yd. Gold Large Dots (4JHM3) for blocks  
1⅞ yds. Dark Blue Small Dots (5JHM3) for blocks and binding  
1 yd. Dark Green Small Dots (5JHM1) for sashing and inner border  
2⅝ yds. Dark Blue Border Print (3JHM1) for outer border  
6½ yds. for backing (vertical seam)

### **Materials: Light Blue Quilt**

- 1⅝ yds. or 2 yds.\* Gray Road Map (1JHM2) for quilt center  
⅔ yd. or 1⅓ yds.\*\* Pastel Tiles (2JHM2) for blocks  
½ yd. Turquoise Large Dots (4JHM4) for blocks  
½ yd. Orange Large Dots (4JHM2) for blocks  
1⅞ yds. Yellow Small Dots (5JHM2) for blocks and binding  
1 yd. Medium Green Small Dots (5JHM4) for sashing and inner border  
2⅝ yds. Light Blue Border Print (3JHM2) for outer border  
6½ yds. for backing (vertical seam)

- \* 2 yds. will allow you more flexibility in choosing which motifs to feature in the center of the quilt.  
\*\*1⅓ yds. provides enough extra fabric to also make the Matching Game (pattern available as a free PDF on our website: [www.inthebeginningfabrics.com](http://www.inthebeginningfabrics.com))



### **Cutting**

*One set of cutting instructions is given, and includes information for both versions of the quilt. Fabrics are cut in order given in Materials lists. Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.*

*From Road Map, cut:*

- 1 piece, 48½" x width of fabric (with rotary cutter and ruler, trim off selvages)

*From Tiles, selectively cut:*

- 6 squares, 8½" x 8½", for star centers (Selectively cut squares to get portion of design – plus seam allowance – as shown in photograph.)

*From Red Large Dots (Teal Quilt) –OR– Turquoise Large Dots (Light Blue Quilt), cut:*

- 2 strips, 4⅞" x 40"; crosscut 12 squares, 4⅞" x 4⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 24 star points

*From Gold Large Dots (Teal Quilt) –OR– Orange Large Dots (Light Blue Quilt), cut:*

- 2 strips, 4⅞" x 40"; crosscut 12 squares, 4⅞" x 4⅞"; cut each square once diagonally to make 24 star points

*From Dark Blue Small Dots (Teal Quilt) –OR– Yellow Small Dots (Light Blue Quilt), cut:*

- 2 strips, 9¼" x 40"; crosscut 6 squares, 9¼" x 9¼"; cut each square twice diagonally to make 24 star background triangles
- 3 strips, 4½" x 40"; crosscut 24 squares, 4½" x 4½" for star corners
- 9 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding

*From Dark Green Small Dots (Teal Quilt) –OR– Medium Green Small Dots (Light Blue Quilt), cut:*

- 10 strips, 2½" x 40", for sashing and inner border

*From Dark Blue Border Print (Teal Quilt) –OR– Light Blue Border Print (Light Blue Quilt), selectively cut:*

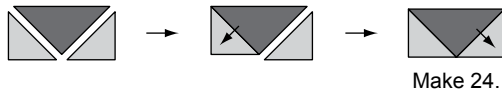
- 4 strips, 10" x length of fabric, for outer border (Selectively cut strips to get portion of design – plus seam allowance – as shown in photograph.)

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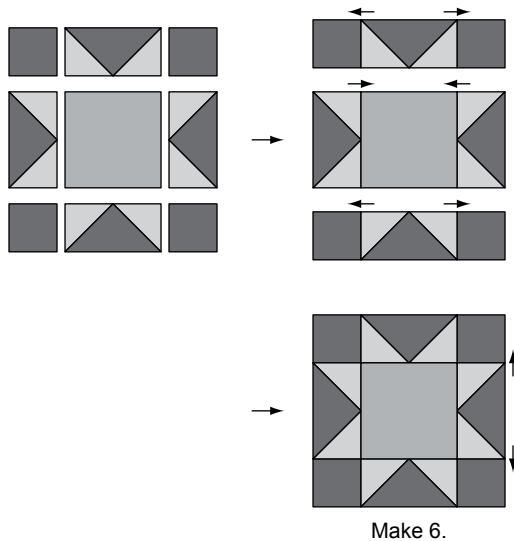
## Assembly

*All seams ¼". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Assembly directions are the same for both quilts. Refer to photographs for fabric placement.*

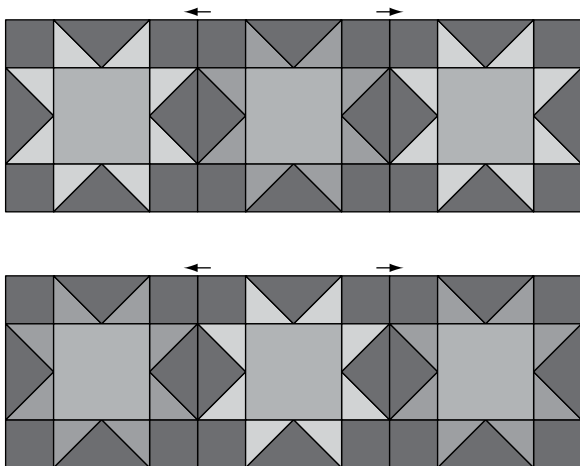
- Using 2 matching Large Dots star point triangles, and 1 Small Dots star background triangle, assemble a star point unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 24 units.



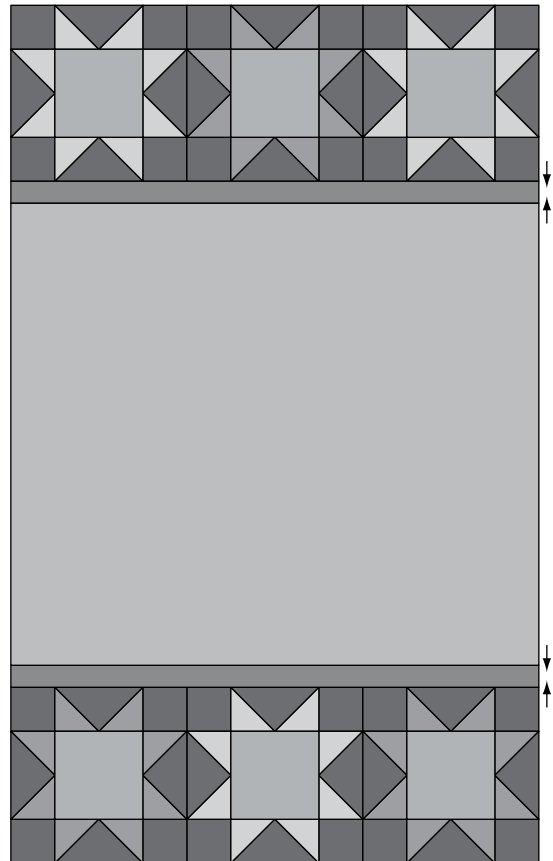
- Using 1 Tiles 8½" square, 4 matching star point units, and 4 Small Dots 4½" star corner squares, assemble a star block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 6 blocks.



- Sew star blocks together in 2 rows as shown, with 3 blocks in each row.



- Sew the ten 2½" x 40" sashing and inner border strips together, end-to-end, to make one long strip. Press seams open.
- From the long strip, cut 2 sashing strips, each 48½" long.
- Sew together the 2 star rows, the 2 sashing strips from Step 5, and the Road Map piece as shown.



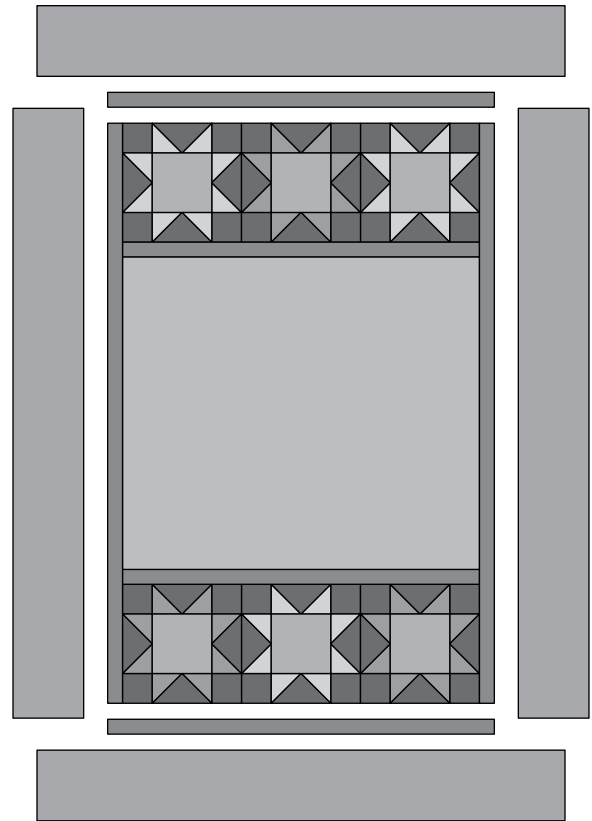
## Borders

- Measure length of quilt top through center. From the long strip made in Assembly Step 4, cut 2 inner border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram on page 3. Press seams toward inner borders.
- Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. From the long strip, cut 2 inner border strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward inner borders.
- Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim 2 of the Border Print outer border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward outer borders.

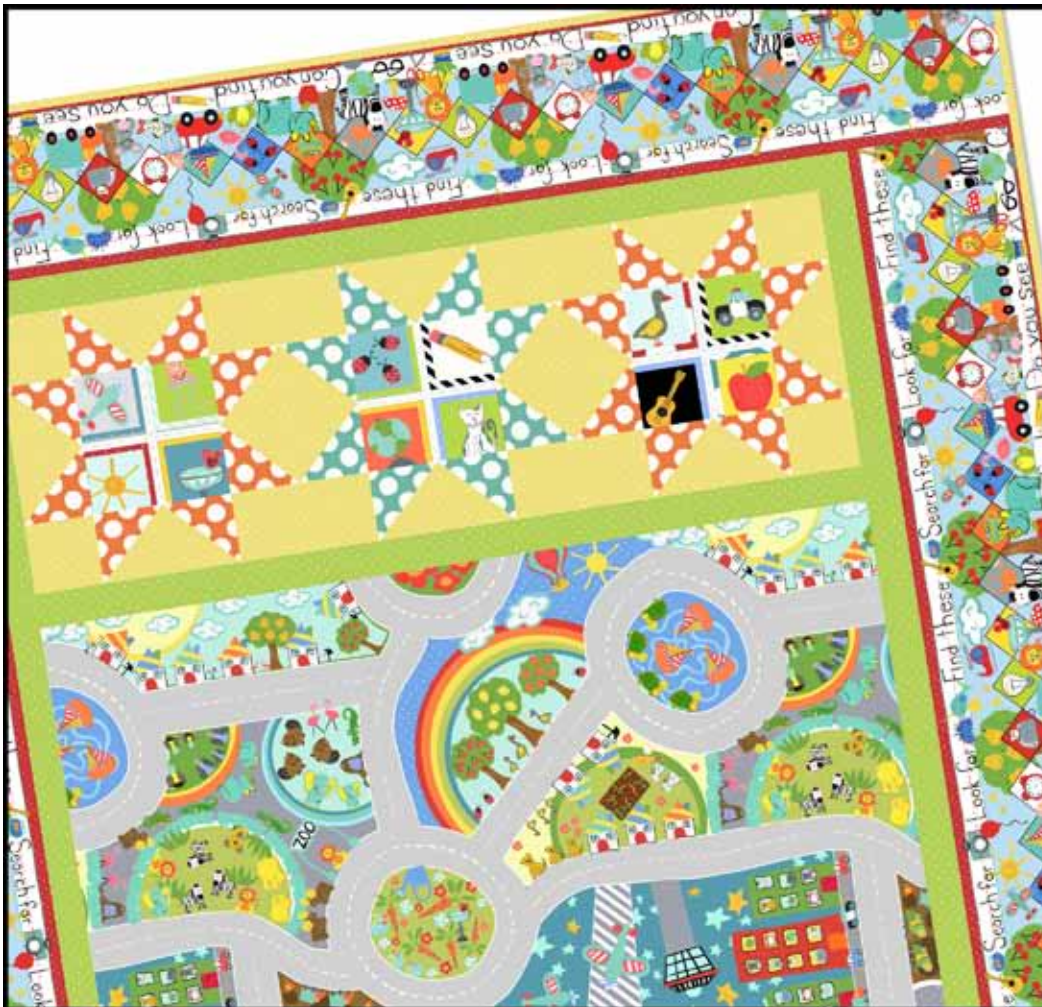
4. Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. Trim remaining 2 Border Print outer border strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward outer borders.

### **Finishing**

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
