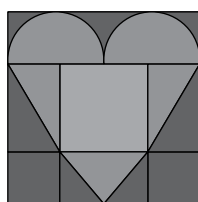

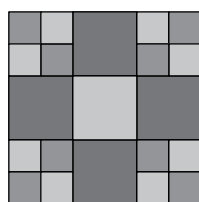

## Materials

- 1/3 yd. Red Heart Panel (1MZ1) for blocks
- 1 3/8 yds. Black/White Dots (8MZ3) for blocks and binding
- 1/3 yd. Red Small Hearts (6MZ1) for blocks
- 1/3 yd. Red Medium Hearts/Flowers (3MZ1) for blocks
- 1/2 yd. Red/White Dots (8MZ1) for blocks
- 3/8 yd. Red Plaid (7MZ1) for blocks
- 3/8 yd. Red/Black Small Hearts/Birds (4MZ1) for blocks
- 2 yds. Red Heart Border Stripe (2MZ1) for border  
(Yardage is generous to allow for selective cutting.)
- 3 1/2 yds. for backing

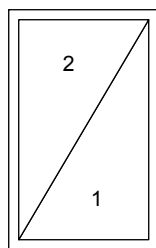
## Cutting

From Red Heart Panel, *selectively cut*:

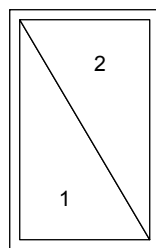
- 5 squares, 6" x 6", for blocks

From Black/White Dots, *cut*:

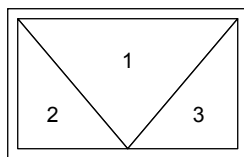
- 6 strips, 2 1/2" x 40", for double-fold binding
- 10 rectangles, 4 1/4" x 6 1/2" (These will be used for foundation piecing the #1 spaces on Foundations A and B.)
- 5 rectangles, 3 3/4" x 12 1/2", for blocks
- 10 squares, 3 3/4" x 3 3/4", for blocks
- 10 rectangles, 3 1/2" x 4 1/4" (These will be used for foundation piecing the #2 and #3 spaces on Foundation C.)

(Full size foundations are on back page.)

From Red Small Hearts, *cut*:

- 6 rectangles, 4 1/4" x 6 1/2" (4 of these will be used for foundation piecing the #2 spaces on Foundations A and B, and 2 will be used for foundation piecing the #1 space on Foundation C.)
- 4 half-circles, using Heart Template, for blocks

**FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 12" x 12"**

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 53" x 53"**

- Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.

From Red Medium Hearts/Flowers, *cut*:

- 6 rectangles, 4 1/4" x 6 1/2" (4 of these will be used for foundation piecing the #2 spaces on Foundations A and B, and 2 will be used for foundation piecing the #1 space on Foundation C.)
- 4 half-circles, using Heart Template, for blocks

From Red/White Dots, *cut*:

- 2 strips, 2 1/2" x 40", for strip-piecing fourpatch units
- 3 rectangles, 4 1/4" x 6 1/2" (2 of these will be used for foundation piecing the #2 spaces on Foundations A and B, and 1 will be used for foundation piecing the #1 space on Foundation C.)
- 2 half-circles, using Heart Template, for blocks

From Red Plaid, *cut*:

- 2 strips, 2 1/2" x 40", for strip-piecing fourpatch units
- 4 squares, 4 1/2" x 4 1/2", for blocks

From Red/Black Small Hearts/Birds, *cut*:

- 16 squares, 4 1/2" x 4 1/2", for blocks

From Red Heart Border Stripe, *selectively cut*:

- 4 strips, 8 3/4" x length of fabric, for border (If you prewash your fabric, you might need to cut your strips narrower than 8 3/4" to get the desired portion of the design.)

## Assembly

**Previous foundation piecing experience is recommended.**

All seams 1/4". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Refer to photograph for fabric placement.

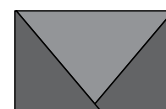
1. Make 5 photocopies each of Foundations A, B, and C.
2. Arrange stacks of all pieces that, in the Cutting instructions, are designated for foundation piecing. These stacks will include: Black/White Dots 4 1/4" x 6 1/2" rectangles, Black/White Dots 3 1/2" x 4 1/4" rectangles, Red Small Hearts 4 1/4" x 6 1/2" rectangles, Red Medium Hearts/Flowers 4 1/4" x 6 1/2" rectangles, and Red/White Dots 4 1/4" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
3. Referring to quilt photograph for fabric placement, and using fabrics from Step 2, foundation piece 5 each of Foundations A, B, and C.

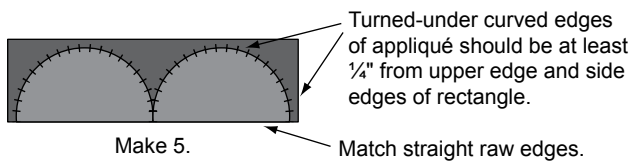

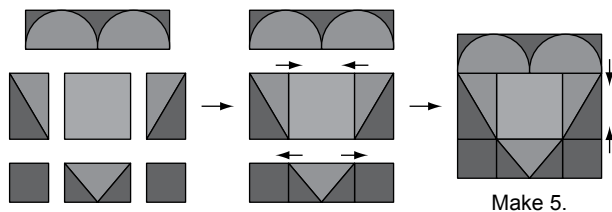
Foundation C

Make 5 of each foundation unit.

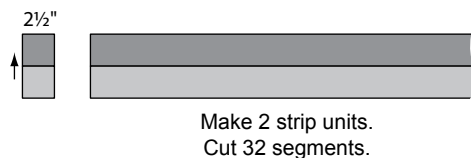
- Select two matching-print Heart Template half-circles. Turn curved edges under  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", and machine- or hand-appliqué to a Black/White Dots  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, with straight raw edges of half-circles matching lower raw edge of rectangle. Repeat to make a total of 5 appliqué units.



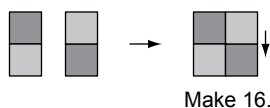
- Using 1 each of matching-print Foundation A, B, and C units from Step 3, 1 matching-print appliqué unit from Step 4, 1 Red Heart Panel 6" square, and 2 Black/White Dots  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " squares, assemble a heart block. Repeat to make a total of 5 blocks.



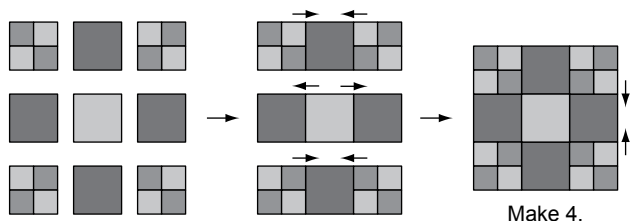
- Using 1 Red/White Dots  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40" strip, and 1 Red Plaid  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40" strip, assemble a strip unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 2 strip units. From the strip units, cut a total of 32 segments, each  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.



- Using 2 segments from Step 6, assemble a fourpatch unit as shown. Repeat to make a total of 16 units.



- Using 4 fourpatch units from Step 7, 4 Red/Black Small Hearts/Birds  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, and 1 Red Plaid  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square, assemble a pieced block as shown. Repeat to make a total of 4 blocks.



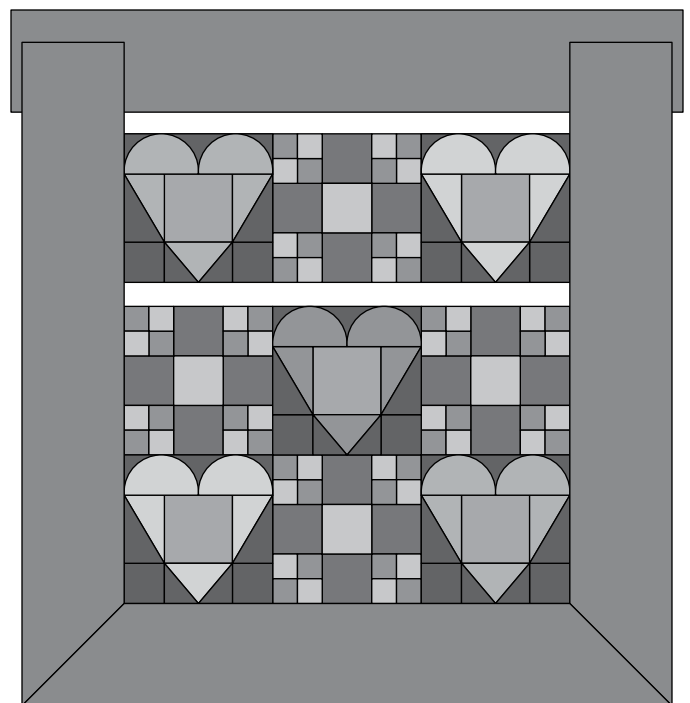
- Sew blocks, made in Steps 5 and 8, into rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Then sew rows together.

## Borders

- Study the photograph and notice that a red heart is at the center of each border strip. To get this effect, first find – and place a pin at – the center of each of the four quilt-top edges. Next, on each of the four Red Heart Border Stripe strips, find the inward-facing heart that is nearest the center of the strip. Lightly crease the border strip to mark the center of the heart.
- With right sides together, and with pinned/creased centers matching, pin border strips to sides of quilt. (The strips will extend beyond the top and bottom edges of the quilt top.) Sew border strips to sides of quilt top, beginning and ending  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from raw edges of quilt. Backstitch to secure. Press seams toward borders. Now, match centers, pin, and sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt top; start and stop your seams at the point where the side borders join the quilt ( $\frac{1}{4}$ " from edges). Backstitch to secure. Press seams toward borders.
- Miter corners using your favorite technique.

## Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
