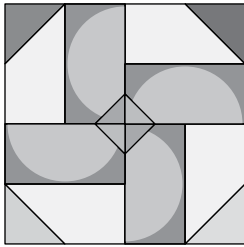

In The Beginning *fabrics*

FINISHED BLOCK SIZE: 12" x 12" • FINISHED QUILT SIZE: 61½" x 73½"

- *Separate materials lists and cutting instructions are given for each of the two quilts.*
- *Yardages are based on 40" fabric width.*



Materials: Green/Black Quilt

1¾ yds. Black/White Dots (8JHB1) for blocks
¼ yd. Red Floral Columns (3JHB3) for blocks
⅜ yd. Black Floral Columns (3JHB1) for blocks
½ yd. Turquoise Tossed Posies (2JHB1) for blocks
⅓ yd. Green Daisy/Butterflies (7JHB1) for blocks
⅓ yd. Black Cherry Circles (5JHB3) for blocks
¼ yd. Red/Orange Dots (8JHB3) for blocks
¼ yd. Yellow/Red Dots (8JHB2) for blocks
⅜ yd. Yellow/Green Dots (8JHB4) for inner border
5⅔ yds. Black/Green Medallions (1JHB1) for blocks and
outer border
¾ yd. Black Vine Stripe (4JHB1) for binding
4⅞ yds. for backing

Materials: Red/Blue Quilt

1¾ yds. Black/White Dots (8JHB1) for blocks
⅜ yd. Blue Floral Columns (3JHB2) for blocks
¼ yd. Red Floral Columns (3JHB3) for blocks
⅜ yd. Yellow Tossed Posies (2JHB3) for blocks
⅓ yd. Blue Daisy/Butterflies (7JHB2) for blocks
⅓ yd. Yellow Cherry Circles (5JHB2) for blocks
¼ yd. Blue Dots (8JHB5) for blocks
½ yd. Yellow/Red Dots (8JHB2) for blocks and inner
border
5⅔ yds. Blue/Yellow Medallions (1JHB2) for blocks and
outer border
¾ yd. Red Vine Stripe (4JHB3) for binding
4⅞ yds. for backing

Cutting: Green/Black Quilt

Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

From Black/White Dots, cut:

- 80 rectangles, 3½" x 6½", for blocks

From Red Floral Columns, cut:

- 7 squares, 3½" x 3½", for blocks

From Black Floral Columns, cut:

- 22 squares, 3½" x 3½", for blocks

From Turquoise Tossed Posies, cut:

- 25 squares, 3½" x 3½", for blocks

From Green Daisy/Butterflies, cut:

- 14 squares, 3½" x 3½", for blocks

From Black Cherry Circles, cut:

- 12 squares, 3½" x 3½", for blocks

From Red/Orange Dots, cut:

- 40 squares, 2" x 2", for blocks

From Yellow/Red Dots, cut:

- 40 squares, 2" x 2", for blocks

From Yellow/Green Dots, cut:

- 6 strips, 1½" x 40", for inner border

From Black/Green Medallions, cut in order given:

- 4 strips, 6" x 65", for outer border (Strips are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)
- 80 rectangles, using Template A (See instructions for making a see-through plastic template on back page. Use plastic template to selectively cut each fabric rectangle so that it contains a half-medallion section of the design, as shown in the quilt photographs.)

From Black Vine Stripe, cut:

- 8 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding

Cutting: Red/Blue Quilt

Cut strips across width of fabric, unless otherwise instructed.

From Black/White Dots, cut:

- 80 rectangles, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", for blocks

From Blue Floral Columns, cut:

- 22 squares, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", for blocks

From Red Floral Columns, cut:

- 7 squares, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", for blocks

From Yellow Tossed Posies, cut:

- 22 squares, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", for blocks

From Blue Daisy/Butterflies, cut:

- 16 squares, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", for blocks

From Yellow Cherry Circles, cut:

- 13 squares, $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", for blocks

From Blue Dots, cut:

- 40 squares, 2" x 2", for blocks

From Yellow/Red Dots, cut:

- 6 strips, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40", for inner border
- 40 squares, 2" x 2", for blocks

From Blue/Yellow Medallions, cut in order given:

- 4 strips, 6" x 65", for outer border (Strips are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)
- 80 rectangles, using Template A (See instructions for making a see-through plastic template on back page. Use plastic template to selectively cut each fabric rectangle so that it contains a half-medallion section of the design, as shown in the quilt photographs.)

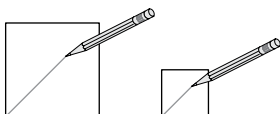
From Red Vine Stripe, cut:

- 8 strips, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 40", for double-fold binding

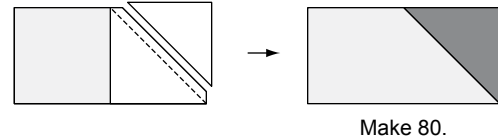
Block Assembly

All seams $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press seams in direction of arrows unless otherwise instructed. Assembly instructions are the same for both quilts. Refer to photographs for fabric placement.

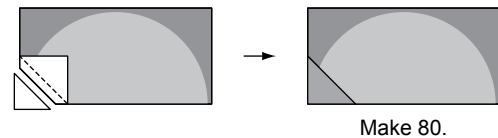
1. Using a pencil and ruler, draw a diagonal line, from corner to corner, on the wrong side of all assorted-print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and all assorted-print 2" squares.



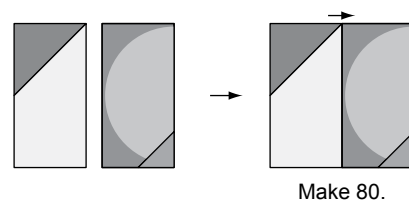
2. With right sides together, place one of the marked $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares at one end of a Black/White Dots $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, being careful to orient it as shown. Sew on the drawn line. Trim as shown, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seam toward triangle. Repeat to make a total of 80 units.



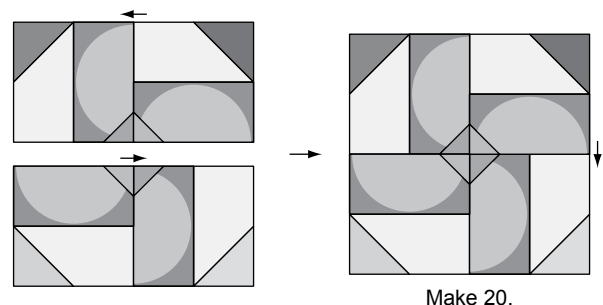
3. With right sides together, place one of the marked 2" squares at one end of a Medallions rectangle, being careful to orient it as shown. Sew on the drawn line. Trim as shown, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seam toward triangle. Repeat to make a total of 80 units.



4. Using 1 rectangle unit from Step 2, and 1 rectangle unit from Step 3, assemble a square unit, being careful to orient pieces as shown. Repeat to make a total of 80 square units.



5. Using 4 square units from Step 4, assemble a block, being careful to orient pieces as shown. Repeat to make a total of 20 blocks.



Quilt Top Assembly

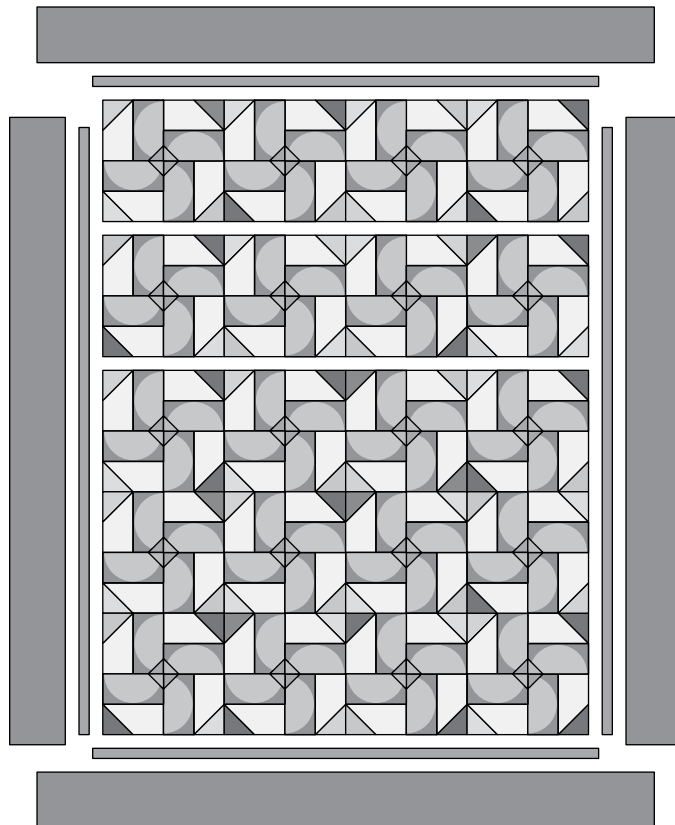
1. Sew blocks together in rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press for opposing seams from row to row.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams in one direction.

Borders

1. Sew 6 Dots inner border strips together, end-to-end, to make one long strip. Press seams open.
2. Measure length of quilt top through center. From the long strip, cut 2 inner border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward inner borders.
3. Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. From the long strip, cut 2 inner border strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward inner borders.
4. Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim 2 Medallions outer border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward outer borders.
5. Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. Trim remaining 2 Medallions outer border strips to this measurement, and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Press seams toward outer borders.

Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
